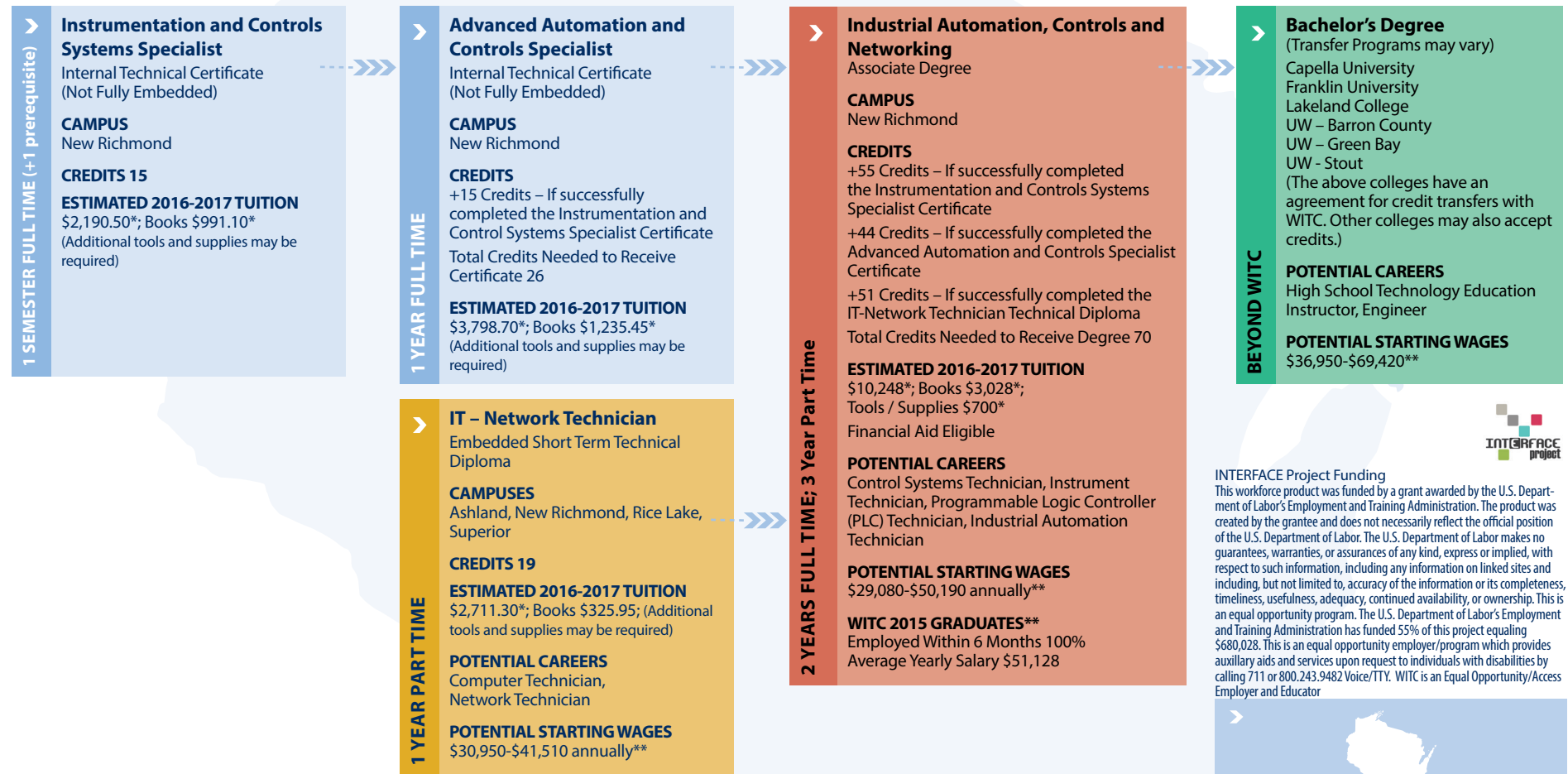

## Admission Steps ([witc.edu/admissions](http://www.witc.edu/admissions)):

**Associate Degree or Technical Diploma** (Full or Part-Time):

**Must complete all three steps.**

1. Apply (include \$30 fee if applicable)
2. Study & Assess – Take the Accuplacer admissions assessment or submit other eligible scores
3. Interview with a WITC counselor
