<b>NEW/EXPANDED CAREER PATHWAY OFFERINGS</b>

• Dental Assistant (expanded)

<b>ACADEMY ( LIKE)</b>
Professional Development 4 hour training offered in all nursing assistant courses

<b>REMEDIAL/BRIDGE COURSES</b>
• Body Structure and Function Course (any health student with low entrance score in science)
• Math Review (all nursing students and any health program student with low math entrance score)
• Medical Terminology (recommended for any new health student with marginal entrance scores)

<b>Nursing Skills/Theory Support</b> - Nursing students
<b>Learning Skills/Reading Support</b> – Physical Therapy Assistant, Medical Lab Technician, Nursing
<b>Health Records/Adam Software Support</b> – Physical Therapy Assistant, Medical Lab Technician, Nursing, Midwife
<b>APA format/Medical writing support</b> – Nursing program
